## Explanation of the headlines and briefs batteries practice

Individual production of a battery of headlines and another one of briefs

Students are expected to prepare 6 headlines (3 lines each) for the beginning of a 20 minutes news radio program

Students are also expected to prepare 4 briefs (5 lines each) to close a section of a 20 minutes news radio program (thematic coherence required in this case: politics, economics, society, education, health, culture or sports)

In both cases, writing has to be as compelling as possible and observe the guidelines explained during the lectures

This practice will be presented by each student at the studio with a tune at the background

Students are expected to take note of all the mistakes that will turn into specific tasks that will be taken into account and assessed for the headlines and briefs batteries of their final practice
